PHONICS AND VOCABULARY BUILDING

ADAPT WORKSHEETS TO SUIT THE CHILD'S INTERESTS. IF THEY LOVE ANIMALS, CHOOSE WORKSHEETS FEATURING DOGS, DUCKS, AND DOLPHINS. PERSONAL CONNECTIONS CAN BOOST MOTIVATION AND RETENTION.
