COMPARING NORTHERN TRUST FEES TO INDUSTRY PEERS

FOR EXAMPLE, FIRMS LIKE CHARLES SCHWAB OR FIDELITY, WHICH CATER TO A BROADER CLIENT BASE, MAY OFFER WEALTH MANAGEMENT SERVICES WITH FEES RANGING BETWEEN 0.50% AND 1.00% BUT OFTEN REQUIRE LOWER MINIMUM BALANCES. CONVERSELY, NORTHERN TRUST'S MINIMUM INVESTMENT THRESHOLDS AND FEES REFLECT ITS SPECIALIZATION IN DELIVERING SOPHISTICATED, CUSTOMIZED SOLUTIONS RATHER THAN MASS-MARKET ADVISORY.

TRANSPARENCY AND NEGOTIABILITY OF FEES

NORTHERN TRUST MAINTAINS A REPUTATION FOR TRANSPARENCY IN ITS FEE DISCLOSURES, PROVIDING DETAILED DOCUMENTATION TO CLIENTS AT ONBOARDING AND PERIODICALLY THROUGHOUT THE RELATIONSHIP. MOREOVER, FEE STRUCTURES CAN BE NEGOTIATED, ESPECIALLY FOR ULTRA-HIGH-NET-WORTH CLIENTS OR INSTITUTIONAL INVESTORS, ENABLING TAILORED ARRANGEMENTS THAT REFLECT THE SCALE AND COMPLEXITY OF THE SERVICES RENDERED.

WHILE SOME CRITICS ARGUE THAT NORTHERN TRUST'S FEES MAY BE ON THE HIGHER SIDE RELATIVE TO ROBO-ADVISORS OR DISCOUNT BROKERAGES, THE FIRM'S VALUE PROPOSITION LIES IN PERSONALIZED SERVICE, ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY PLATFORMS, AND ACCESS TO EXCLUSIVE INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES, WHICH JUSTIFY THE COST FOR MANY CLIENTS.
