1. TEXT SELECTION AND PREPARATION

4. ACTIVE ENGAGEMENT AND RESPONSE

DIFFERENTIATE INSTRUCTION

HOWEVER, IT IS IMPORTANT TO RECOGNIZE POTENTIAL LIMITATIONS. THE DIRECTED READING APPROACH CAN BE TIME-INTENSIVE FOR EDUCATORS, REQUIRING CAREFUL PLANNING AND MONITORING. ADDITIONALLY, IF NOT ADAPTED TO STUDENT NEEDS, IT MAY NOT FULLY CATER TO DIVERSE LEARNING STYLES OR ABILITIES.

ASSESSMENT AND FEEDBACK MECHANISMS
