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imprisoned by the then antichrist, Napoleon, instituted the Feast of the Most Precious Blood on July 1st, 1849, in thanksgiving to God, for his release from Gaeta after the revolution of 1848, because, as he said, he 'owed' his release from prison to the Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ. Our souls are created in God's image and are very precious to Him, but through sin, we enslaved ourselves to the devil. God, in the person of Jesus Christ paid the Price to free us. Not in the perishable gold or silver of this world, but in the supernatural imperishable gold of His Most Precious Blood, as no other price was acceptable. The pagan sacrifices could not do it (cf. Heb 10:4). Even the sacrifices of the blood of goats and bulls, commanded by God in Exodus 12, could not do it. It cost God, His Blood to free and save us. Fr. Faber and numerous Saints tell us that the Church is the Temple of the Most Precious Blood, and that the seven Sacraments are the channels through which this Most Precious Blood is sprinkled on our souls. St. Paul warned those who treat the Precious Blood as a cheap thing or with irreverence. Liturgical abuse and theological dissent from the constant Papal Magisterial teachings and general lack of discipline against the Sacraments and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass offends Heaven greatly and they are costly, endangering the salvation of many. How much more do you think he deserveth worse punishments, who hath trodden underfoot the Son of God and hath esteemed the Blood of the Testament unclean by which he was sanctified, and hath offered an affront to the spirit of grace? (Heb 10:29). Catholic institutions have now become Theological Laboratories, where 'new theories' are tested, while many protestant errors are openly taught and practiced by many theologians, within Catholicism, leading many astray. It is not the 'Opino Theologorum' (Opinion of Theologians), which today, contradicts many century - old Papal teachings, that matters, rather it is the 'Sensus Ecclesiae' (the Mind of the Church- as seen in old Church documents and Papal teachings). M, 1929 Reverend Mother Catherine Aurelia of the Precious Blood (Aurelia Caouette), was born in Saint Hyacinthe, (formerly in the diocese of Montreal), on July 11th, 1833, the seventh of nine children. On September 14th, 1861, four members of the first Contemplative Community in Canada was established, in the house of Aurelia's father. On September 14, 1863, the nuns moved into their own monastery. That same day, Aurelia Caouette took her vows and became Mother Catherine Aurelia of the Precious Blood and Superior. She composed a document called Sitio (I am thirsty), which would become the basis of their rule. She founded the Sisters Adorers of the Precious Blood, an institute of nuns who should strive to adore the Divine Savior and to make reparation, through their love and daily immolations, for the contempt and sins of men. The Foundress passed away peacefully on July 6, 1905. Today, the Institute has various Monasteries in the United States, Canada, and Japan.

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
