3. **TWO ADJACENT ANGLES FORM A LINEAR PAIR, WITH ONE ANGLE MEASURING 110 DEGREES. WHAT IS THE MEASURE OF THE ADJACENT ANGLE?**
SOLUTION HINT: LINEAR PAIRS SUM TO 180 DEGREES; SUBTRACT 110 FROM 180.
4. **COMPLEMENTARY ANGLES HAVE A DIFFERENCE OF 20 DEGREES. FIND THE MEASURE OF THE SMALLER ANGLE.**
SOLUTION HINT: LET THE SMALLER ANGLE BE x , THEN THE LARGER IS $x + 20$. THEIR SUM EQUALS 90 DEGREES.
5. **TWO ANGLES ARE ADJACENT AND SUPPLEMENTARY. ONE ANGLE IS TWICE THE MEASURE OF THE OTHER. FIND THEIR MEASURES.**
SOLUTION HINT: LET ONE ANGLE BE x , THE OTHER $2x$, AND THEIR SUM 180 DEGREES.

THESE PROBLEMS ENCOURAGE APPLICATION OF ANGLE RELATIONSHIPS AND ALGEBRAIC REASONING, MAKING THEM A GREAT FIT FOR PRACTICE SETS WITH ANSWER KEYS.

WHAT COMMON MISTAKES SHOULD I AVOID WHEN PRACTICING ANGLE RELATIONSHIP WORD PROBLEMS?

COMMON MISTAKES INCLUDE MISIDENTIFYING ANGLE RELATIONSHIPS, FORGETTING TO SET UP THE CORRECT EQUATION, ARITHMETIC ERRORS WHEN SOLVING EQUATIONS, AND NOT CHECKING IF THE FINAL ANSWERS MAKE SENSE.
