3. EXPRESSIONS AND EQUATIONS

AT THIS STAGE, STUDENTS BEGIN TO WORK WITH ALGEBRAIC EXPRESSIONS AND SIMPLE EQUATIONS. THE STANDARDS ENCOURAGE LEARNERS TO RECOGNIZE PATTERNS, USE VARIABLES TO REPRESENT NUMBERS, AND SOLVE ONE-STEP AND TWO-STEP EQUATIONS.
