- ****SERIAL NUMBER RANGES****: FOR EXAMPLE, RIFLES WITH SERIAL NUMBERS BELOW 300,000 WERE MADE BETWEEN 1903 AND 1917.
- ****DATE STAMPS****: SOME RIFLES ALSO HAVE DATE STAMPS ON THE BARREL OR RECEIVER, INDICATING THE YEAR OF MANUFACTURE OR BARREL REPLACEMENT.

MANUFACTURER MARKINGS AND PROOF STAMPS

THE SPRINGFIELD 1903 WAS PRODUCED NOT ONLY BY SPRINGFIELD ARMORY BUT ALSO BY OTHER MANUFACTURERS DURING WARTIME TO MEET DEMAND. IDENTIFYING MANUFACTURER MARKINGS IS CRITICAL IN DETERMINING THE RIFLE'S ORIGIN.

- ****SPRINGFIELD ARMORY****: TYPICALLY MARKED WITH "SPRINGFIELD" ON THE RECEIVER.
- ****WINCHESTER AND REMINGTON****: BOTH COMPANIES PRODUCED RIFLES UNDER CONTRACT DURING WORLD WAR I AND WORLD WAR II, AND THEIR RIFLES BEAR RESPECTIVE MANUFACTURER'S MARKS.
- ****PROOF MARKS****: LOOK FOR PROOF STAMPS ON THE BARREL AND RECEIVER, WHICH INDICATE INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

BY MILITARY OFFICIALS.

THESE MARKINGS CAN ADD SIGNIFICANT VALUE AND HISTORICAL CONTEXT TO THE RIFLE.

CALIBER AND BARREL CHARACTERISTICS

THE ORIGINAL SPRINGFIELD 1903 WAS CHAMBERED IN .30-03 CALIBER, BUT MOST WERE CONVERTED OR MANUFACTURED TO FIRE THE .30-06 SPRINGFIELD CARTRIDGE AFTER 1906. IDENTIFYING THE CALIBER CAN BE DONE BY:

- READING THE BARREL STAMP, WHICH OFTEN INCLUDES CALIBER INFORMATION.
- MEASURING THE BORE DIAMETER IF THE MARKINGS ARE UNCLEAR.
- CONSIDERING THE MODEL VARIANT, AS SOME SPECIAL VERSIONS LIKE THE M1903A3 AND M1903A4 HAD OTHER CALIBER ADAPTATIONS.

BARREL LENGTH AND RIFLING PATTERNS CAN ALSO HELP DIFFERENTIATE BETWEEN PRODUCTION YEARS AND MODEL VARIATIONS.
