Using the method of adjusting events and biography to the prophecies of the Hebrew prophets, Roman political technologists came up with a biography, demeanor, and texts of sermons for this fictional character - corresponding to the predictions. After the harsh suppression of the Jews during the First Jewish War (66-77), Rome was in dire need of agents of influence in order to curb the aggression of the people and reconcile them with defeat. It is at this stage that the image of the hitherto unknown Jesus enters the historical arena. This fictional Jewish character called his people to humility, patience, calmness, obedience to Rome. He offered not to blame Rome for anything, and to look for the roots of all troubles in himself, and in the Jewish Bible ("Christian pacifism" and "Christian anti-Semitism"). All the power of the propaganda machine of Rome was connected to the promotion of his ideas in the Middle East. It was at this time (after the "First Jewish War") that the entire Middle East was enveloped in a boom of missionaries (in the guise of prostitutes, merchants, merchants, artisans, travelers, teachers, mentors, "apostles", philanthropists, etc. agents of influence) propagating ideas this fictitious prophet. As the ideas of Christianity spread, a split and confrontation began to grow in the Jewish community, which the Roman administrative bodies tried to do. Guided by its standard policy of Divide and Conquer!, Rome used these methods to oppose different layers of the Aramaean-Jewish society, weakened and very easily conquered the entire Middle East and the Black Sea region. Before the final rooting of a new artificial religion (Christianity) in the Middle East and the Black Sea region, Rome carefully camouflaged its participation in its formation so as not to extradite its agents abroad and not disclose their source of funding.
