THANK YOU NOTES AND SURVEYS

SEND PERSONALIZED THANK YOU MESSAGES TO PLAYERS, SPONSORS, AND VOLUNTEERS. INCLUDING A SURVEY CAN GATHER VALUABLE FEEDBACK TO IMPROVE FUTURE EVENTS.

SHARING HIGHLIGHTS

CONSIDER SENDING A RECAP EMAIL WITH PHOTOS, SCORE SUMMARIES, AND ANNOUNCEMENTS OF WINNERS. POSTING ON SOCIAL MEDIA CAN ALSO KEEP THE COMMUNITY ENGAGED.
