THE MAGAZINE OF FANTASY SCIENCE FICTION (OFTEN ABBREVIATED AS F&SF) EMERGED DURING THE POST-WAR BOOM OF GENRE MAGAZINES, A PERIOD THAT SAW INCREASED INTEREST IN SPECULATIVE FICTION ACROSS THE UNITED STATES AND BEYOND. FOUNDED BY JOSEPH W. FERMAN AND INITIALLY EDITED BY ANTHONY BOUCHER AND J. FRANCIS MCCOMAS, F&SF DISTINGUISHED ITSELF THROUGH A COMMITMENT TO LITERARY QUALITY AND EDITORIAL INNOVATION. UNLIKE MANY CONTEMPORARIES, WHICH OFTEN PRIORITIZED SENSATIONALISM OR FORMULAIC STORYTELLING, F&SF SOUGHT TO ELEVATE THE GENRE BY PUBLISHING STORIES THAT CHALLENGED READERS INTELLECTUALLY AND EMOTIONALLY.

OVER THE DECADES, THE MAGAZINE'S EDITORIAL STANCE HAS ADAPTED TO CHANGING TASTES AND CULTURAL CURRENTS, YET IT HAS CONSISTENTLY MAINTAINED AN EMPHASIS ON NARRATIVE CRAFT AND ORIGINALITY. THIS FLEXIBILITY HAS BEEN BOTH A STRENGTH AND, AT TIMES, A CHALLENGE, AS THE MAGAZINE MUST BALANCE VARIED AUDIENCE EXPECTATIONS.
