THIS CLEVER TWIST MAKES THE ECHO A PERFECT METAPHOR FOR COMMUNICATION THAT TRANSCENDS LINGUISTIC BOUNDARIES.

WHY AN ECHO FITS THE RIDDLE PERFECTLY

- ****MIMICS ANY SOUND:**** AN ECHO REFLECTS WHATEVER IS SPOKEN, REGARDLESS OF THE LANGUAGE.
