## 3. TAKE NOTES AND CREATE A MISTAKE LOG

KEEP A DEDICATED NOTEBOOK OR DIGITAL DOCUMENT FOR QUESTIONS YOU GOT WRONG OR TOPICS YOU FOUND CONFUSING. PERIODICALLY REVIEW THIS LOG TO REINFORCE THOSE CONCEPTS AND AVOID REPEATING MISTAKES.

## 4. MIX QUESTION DIFFICULTY

START WITH EASIER QUESTIONS TO BUILD CONFIDENCE, THEN GRADUALLY MOVE TO MORE CHALLENGING ONES. THIS STAGED APPROACH HELPS YOU BUILD A STRONG FOUNDATION BEFORE TACKLING COMPLEX CLINICAL SCENARIOS.

## 5. INTEGRATE QUESTIONS WITH OTHER STUDY MATERIALS

DON'T RELY SOLELY ON PRACTICE QUESTIONS. USE THEM ALONGSIDE TEXTBOOKS, LECTURE NOTES, AND CLINICAL EXPERIENCES TO CREATE A WELL-ROUNDED PREPARATION PLAN.
