More recent studies of the Comanches have focused on adaptation and persistence in Comanche lifestyles and on Comanche political organization and language-based alliances. In *Comanche Society: Before the Reservation*, Gerald Betty develops an exciting and sophisticated perspective on the driving force of Comanche life: kinship.
