2. **COMBINE WITH MULTISENSORY ACTIVITIES:** USE TACTILE TOOLS LIKE SAND TRAYS OR FINGER TRACING TO COMPLEMENT WORKSHEET USE.
3. **MONITOR PROGRESS:** REGULARLY ASSESS HANDWRITING SAMPLES TO IDENTIFY AREAS NEEDING REINFORCEMENT.
4. **ENCOURAGE PROPER POSTURE AND GRIP:** PHYSICAL COMFORT SUPPORTS HANDWRITING QUALITY AND ENDURANCE.
5. **ADAPT WORKSHEET DIFFICULTY:** TAILOR THE WORKSHEETS TO THE LEARNER'S PACE, GRADUALLY INCREASING COMPLEXITY.
