THE USE OF PARABLES AND APHORISMS WAS NOT MERELY RHETORICAL BUT SERVED AS A METHOD TO ENGAGE LISTENERS IN CRITICAL REFLECTION, OFTEN CHALLENGING ESTABLISHED RELIGIOUS AND SOCIAL NORMS. JESUS'S EMPHASIS ON INNER SPIRITUALITY OVER EXTERNAL RITUALISM REPRESENTED A SIGNIFICANT DEPARTURE FROM PREVAILING RELIGIOUS PRACTICES OF HIS TIME.

MIRACLES AND HEALING

FROM A HISTORICAL-CRITICAL PERSPECTIVE, THE MIRACLES ARE DEBATED IN TERMS OF THEIR SYMBOLIC MEANING AND HISTORICAL VERACITY, YET THEIR IMPACT ON EARLY CHRISTIAN COMMUNITIES WAS PROFOUND.

CRUCIFIXION AND RESURRECTION: CENTRAL EVENTS

TRIAL AND EXECUTION

THE CULMINATION OF THE LIFE OF OUR LORD AND SAVIOUR JESUS CHRIST IS MARKED BY HIS CRUCIFIXION, A METHOD OF EXECUTION EMPLOYED BY THE ROMAN AUTHORITIES FOR INSURRECTIONISTS AND CRIMINALS. THE CRUCIFIXION, OCCURRING AROUND 30-33 CE, IS A HISTORICALLY ATTESTED EVENT, CORROBORATED BY MULTIPLE SOURCES BEYOND THE NEW TESTAMENT. IT SYMBOLIZES BOTH THE SUFFERING AND SACRIFICE CENTRAL TO CHRISTIAN THEOLOGY AND SERVES AS A FOCAL POINT FOR UNDERSTANDING JESUS'S MISSION.

RESURRECTION AND ITS SIGNIFICANCE

PERHAPS THE MOST DEFINING ELEMENT OF THE LIFE OF OUR LORD AND SAVIOUR JESUS CHRIST IS THE RESURRECTION NARRATIVE. ACCORDING TO CHRISTIAN BELIEF, JESUS ROSE FROM THE DEAD THREE DAYS AFTER HIS CRUCIFIXION, AN EVENT CELEBRATED AS EASTER.
