- 3: UNRESPONSIVE

UNDERSTANDING THE SUBTLE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THESE SCORES IS VITAL. FOR EXAMPLE, A PATIENT WHO OPENS EYES ONLY AFTER REPEATED CALLS SCORES A 2, NOT A 3. MISINTERPRETING THESE CAN LEAD TO INCORRECT NIHSS SCORING AND AFFECT CLINICAL DECISIONS.

## BEST GAZE – ITEM 2

THIS ITEM EVALUATES THE HORIZONTAL EYE MOVEMENT AND GAZE PREFERENCE:

- 0: NORMAL
- 1: PARTIAL GAZE Palsy (SOME LIMITATION BUT CAN LOOK TO ONE SIDE)
- 2: FORCED DEVIATION (CANNOT LOOK AWAY FROM THE PARETIC SIDE)

THE CERTIFICATION TEST OFTEN INCLUDES VIDEOS OR SCENARIOS WHERE YOU IDENTIFY GAZE ABNORMALITIES. RECOGNIZING FORCED DEVIATION VS. PARTIAL GAZE Palsy IS A COMMON CHALLENGE, SO REVIEWING CLINICAL EXAMPLES IS HELPFUL.

## VISUAL FIELDS – ITEM 3

VISUAL FIELD TESTING IDENTIFIES HEMIANOPIA OR OTHER DEFICITS:

- 0: NO VISUAL LOSS
- 1: PARTIAL HEMIANOPIA
- 2: COMPLETE HEMIANOPIA
- 3: BILATERAL HEMIANOPIA (BLIND INCLUDING CORTICAL BLINDNESS)

THIS TEST REQUIRES ATTENTION TO PATIENT RESPONSES AND SOMETIMES SUBTLE VISUAL FIELD CUTS. PRACTICING WITH DIAGRAMS AND PATIENT SCENARIOS BOOSTS YOUR ACCURACY ON THIS ITEM.

## TIPS FOR NAVIGATING NIHSS CERTIFICATION TEST ANSWERS GROUP A

THIS DEEPER CLINICAL UNDERSTANDING OFTEN SEPARATES THOSE WHO MERELY MEMORIZE ANSWERS FROM THOSE WHO CAN APPLY THEIR KNOWLEDGE EFFECTIVELY IN REAL-WORLD SCENARIOS.

## COMPARING GROUP A TO OTHER SECTIONS OF THE NIHSS CERTIFICATION

3. **JOIN STUDY GROUPS OR ONLINE FORUMS:** COLLABORATE WITH PEERS TO DISCUSS CHALLENGING QUESTIONS AND SHARE INSIGHTS ABOUT COMMON PITFALLS IN GROUP A.
