HOWEVER, TRADITIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMS CAN BE COSTLY, OFTEN RANGING FROM SEVERAL HUNDRED TO THOUSANDS OF DOLLARS, WHICH CAN DETER POTENTIAL CANDIDATES. VARIABLE PROGRAM QUALITY

- **JOB GUARANTEES:** EMPLOYER-SPONSORED TUITION FREE PROGRAMS MAY PROVIDE JOB PLACEMENT, WHICH IS LESS COMMON IN PAID PROGRAMS.

ULTIMATELY, THE CHOICE DEPENDS ON INDIVIDUAL CIRCUMSTANCES, INCLUDING FINANCIAL SITUATION, CAREER GOALS, GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION, AND AVAILABILITY OF PROGRAMS.
