2. HOW CAN I PREPARE FOR THE IU PLAGIARISM TEST?

PREPARATION GOES BEYOND JUST PASSING THE TEST. IT INVOLVES:

- **UNDERSTANDING WHAT PLAGIARISM IS**: COPYING TEXT, IDEAS, IMAGES, OR DATA WITHOUT PROPER ACKNOWLEDGMENT.

ALWAYS FOLLOW PARAPHRASING WITH A CITATION TO GIVE CREDIT WHERE DUE. WHEN QUOTING DIRECTLY, USE QUOTATION MARKS AND CITE THE SOURCE IMMEDIATELY.

TIPS FOR WRITING ORIGINAL CONTENT THAT PASSES IU'S PLAGIARISM TEST

WRITING AUTHENTICALLY CAN FEEL CHALLENGING, BUT IT'S A SKILL THAT IMPROVES WITH PRACTICE. HERE ARE SOME HELPFUL TIPS:
