THE LEGACY OF PALE FIRE BY VLADIMIR NABOKOV IN LITERATURE

THEMATIC DEPTH AND LITERARY DEVICES

BEYOND ITS STRUCTURE, *PALE FIRE* IS A RICH TAPESTRY OF THEMES AND LITERARY DEVICES THAT REFLECT NABOKOV'S PREOCCUPATIONS WITH IDENTITY, MORTALITY, AND ARTISTIC CREATION.
