4. MAIN TRAINING ACTIVITIES

ADJUST FREQUENCY AND DURATION

PUPPIES GENERALLY HAVE SHORTER ATTENTION SPANS AND BENEFIT FROM BRIEF BUT FREQUENT TRAINING SESSIONS, WHEREAS ADULT DOGS CAN HANDLE LONGER, MORE FOCUSED LESSONS. YOUR LESSON PLAN TEMPLATE CAN INCLUDE SECTIONS TO NOTE IDEAL SESSION LENGTHS AND BREAKS TO KEEP YOUR DOG ENGAGED WITHOUT FATIGUE.

TRACK PROGRESS AND ADJUST GOALS

****REINFORCEMENT:**** PRAISE AND TREAT IMMEDIATELY WHEN DOG SITS.

****COOL-DOWN:**** GENTLE PETTING AND PLAY WITH FAVORITE TOY.

****NOTES:**** DOG RESPONDED WELL TO HAND GESTURE, NEEDS MORE PRACTICE WITH VERBAL CUE.
