EVERY DAY, NYA EMBARKS ON A LONG WALK TO A POND, A JOURNEY THAT CONSUMES HOURS OF HER TIME AND ENERGY. THIS WALK IS NOT JUST A PHYSICAL TREK; IT SYMBOLIZES THE RESILIENCE AND DETERMINATION REQUIRED TO SURVIVE IN SUCH HARSH CONDITIONS.

THE REALITY OF WATER SCARCITY IN SOUTH SUDAN

WATER SCARCITY IS A CRITICAL ISSUE IN SOUTH SUDAN, WHERE COMMUNITIES OFTEN RELY ON CONTAMINATED PONDS OR RIVERS. FOR MANY, LIKE NYA, THE NEAREST CLEAN WATER SOURCE CAN BE SEVERAL MILES AWAY. THIS SCARCITY AFFECTS HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND OVERALL QUALITY OF LIFE.
