THE RIDDLES ARE WRITTEN IN OLD ENGLISH AND RANGE FROM STRAIGHTFORWARD DESCRIPTIONS OF EVERYDAY OBJECTS TO MORE ABSTRACT AND METAPHORICAL CHALLENGES. THEY OFTEN USE METAPHOR, WORDPLAY, AND VIVID IMAGERY TO DISGUISE THEIR SUBJECTS, INVITING READERS TO GUESS WHAT IS BEING DESCRIBED.

THE EXETER BOOK: A TREASURE TROVE OF OLD ENGLISH

THE EXETER BOOK ITSELF IS ONE OF THE FOUR MAJOR SURVIVING MANUSCRIPTS OF OLD ENGLISH POETRY, ALONGSIDE THE BEOWULF MANUSCRIPT, THE VERCELLI BOOK, AND THE JUNIUS MANUSCRIPT. COMPILED IN THE LATE 10TH CENTURY, IT CONTAINS A RICH ANTHOLOGY OF RELIGIOUS POEMS, ELEGIES, AND THE RIDDLES THAT BEAR ITS NAME. THE RIDDLES STAND OUT BECAUSE OF THEIR SHEER VARIETY AND THE PLAYFUL TONE THAT CONTRASTS WITH THE OFTEN SOLEMN RELIGIOUS TEXTS SURROUNDING THEM.

THE THEMES AND SUBJECTS OF THE EXETER RIDDLES

ONE OF THE MOST INTRIGUING ASPECTS OF THE EXETER RIDDLES IS THEIR WIDE-RANGING SUBJECT MATTER. WHY THESE THEMES MATTER

UNDERSTANDING THE SUBJECTS OF THE EXETER RIDDLES HELPS US APPRECIATE THE MINDSET OF THE ANGLO-SAXONS. THEIR USE

OF METAPHOR AND INDIRECT DESCRIPTION NOT ONLY ENTERTAINED BUT ALSO DEMONSTRATED INTELLECTUAL SKILL. THE RIDDLES WERE LIKELY SHARED ORALLY, SERVING AS BOTH EDUCATION AND AMUSEMENT IN A LARGELY ORAL CULTURE.

LANGUAGE AND STYLE IN THE EXETER RIDDLES

RIDDLE 33: THE ICE

FOCUSING ON ICE, THIS RIDDLE USES VIVID DESCRIPTIONS OF COLDNESS AND FRAGILITY, INVITING READERS TO VISUALIZE A NATURAL PHENOMENON THROUGH METAPHOR.

EACH RIDDLE INVITES READERS INTO A MENTAL PUZZLE THAT CAN BE BOTH FUN AND INTELLECTUALLY STIMULATING.

AMONG THESE, THE COLLECTION OF NEARLY 100 RIDDLES STANDS OUT FOR ITS UNIQUE BLEND OF WIT AND WORDPLAY.

THE RIDDLES THEMSELVES ARE SHORT, ENIGMATIC POEMS THAT TYPICALLY DESCRIBE AN OBJECT OR CONCEPT THROUGH METAPHOR AND PERSONIFICATION, INVITING READERS TO IDENTIFY THE SUBJECT. THE EXETER BOOK, BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN COMPILED BY ONE OR MORE ANONYMOUS SCRIBES, REFLECTS THE INTELLECTUAL CURIOSITY AND LINGUISTIC CREATIVITY OF

Anglo-Saxon England. The physical manuscript bears signs of wear and damage, which have complicated efforts to fully reconstruct some riddles, but the surviving texts continue to inspire scholarly debate and interpretation.

One of the foremost challenges in studying the Exeter Riddles lies in their translation and interpretation. For example, Riddle 25, which describes a "shadow" that "follows" a person closely, can be read literally or metaphorically, depending on the translator's perspective.

An intriguing aspect of the Exeter Riddles is their occasional use of humor and sensual imagery. Several riddles incorporate double meanings that might be considered risqué, reflecting a facet of Anglo-Saxon culture that contrasts with the often solemn tone of contemporary texts. This facet has led modern critics to view the riddles not only as linguistic puzzles but as vehicles for social commentary and human experience.

There are collections of riddles in Sanskrit, Hebrew, Arabic, Persian, Greek and Latin literature. Well-known is the sphinx as riddling beast in Grecian mythology and literature. Western riddles collections begin with the Latin collections by Symphosius in the late antiquity followed by Aldhelm's and Tatwine's collections. The earliest known English riddles are recorded in the Exeter Book. They originate from the 10th century. These riddles have a very special character. Craig Williamson describes them as "a metaphoric and metamorphic celebration of the life in the eye of the Anglo-Saxon." The Exeter Riddles will be topic to this paper. First their history and transmission will be thematised by having a closer look at the Exeter Cathedral, its library and the Exeter Book. Then typical features of the riddles shall be discussed.
