RELEVANCE OF SPECIAL PROVIDENCE IN CONTEMPORARY GEOPOLITICS

OTHERS SUGGEST THAT MEAD'S FRAMEWORK MAY UNDERSTATE THE INFLUENCE OF ECONOMIC INTERESTS OR NON-STATE ACTORS IN SHAPING POLICY.

NONETHELESS, THESE CRITIQUES UNDERSCORE THE IMPORTANCE OF MEAD'S CONTRIBUTION AS A STARTING POINT FOR DEEPER DISCUSSIONS ABOUT AMERICA'S IDENTITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES ON THE WORLD STAGE.
