PROPORTIONS TAKE RATIOS A STEP FURTHER BY STATING THAT TWO RATIOS ARE EQUAL. FOR INSTANCE, IF $1/6 = 2/12$, THEN THESE TWO RATIOS FORM A PROPORTION. PRACTICING PROPORTIONS SHARPENS THE ABILITY TO SOLVE FOR UNKNOWN VALUES IN EQUATIONS, AN ESSENTIAL SKILL IN ALGEBRA.

FUNCTIONS AND MAPPINGS

RELATIONS CAN ALSO BE REPRESENTED AS FUNCTIONS, WHERE EACH INPUT CORRESPONDS TO A UNIQUE OUTPUT. 3. LEVERAGE VISUAL AIDS

CHARTS, GRAPHS, AND DIAGRAMS ARE INVALUABLE TOOLS. USING VISUAL AIDS TO REPRESENT RELATIONS PROVIDES CLARITY AND AIDS IN RETENTION. TOOLS LIKE PIE CHARTS FOR PARTS OF A WHOLE OR LINE GRAPHS FOR LINEAR RELATIONS CAN BRING ABSTRACT CONCEPTS TO LIFE.

4. PRACTICE WITH VARIED EXERCISES

DIVERSITY IN PRACTICE PROBLEMS STRENGTHENS UNDERSTANDING. MIX SIMPLE RATIO CALCULATIONS WITH WORD PROBLEMS, MAPPING EXERCISES, AND GRAPHING TASKS. THIS VARIETY ENSURES THAT SKILLS ARE WELL-ROUNDED AND ADAPTABLE.

5. USE TECHNOLOGY AND INTERACTIVE TOOLS
