THE PLOT IN BRIEF

AT ITS CORE, **DESPAIR** IS A TALE OF MISTAKEN IDENTITY AND EXISTENTIAL DISINTEGRATION. HERMANN, THE NARRATOR, CONCOCTS A PLAN TO MURDER HIS LOOK-ALIKE, BELIEVING THAT THE CRIME WILL GO UNNOTICED DUE TO THEIR UNCANNY RESEMBLANCE. THE THEME OF IDENTITY AND DOPPELGÄNGERS

PSYCHOLOGICAL LAYERS AND UNRELIABLE NARRATION
