THESE AUCTIONS CAN BE HELD IN PERSON OR ONLINE, AND PARTICIPANTS BID COMPETITIVELY ON THE UNITS. THE HIGHEST BIDDER WINS THE RIGHT TO TAKE POSSESSION OF EVERYTHING INSIDE THE UNIT.

SOME KEY POINTS ABOUT THESE AUCTIONS INCLUDE:

IT'S EASY TO GET CAUGHT UP IN BIDDING WARS, BUT SETTING A CLEAR BUDGET BEFOREHAND HELPS AVOID OVERSPENDING. REMEMBER TO FACTOR IN ADDITIONAL COSTS SUCH AS TRANSPORTATION, STORAGE FEES, AND POTENTIAL CLEANUP EXPENSES.

LEARN TO READ UNITS FROM THE OUTSIDE

SINCE BUYERS OFTEN CANNOT INSPECT THE INTERIOR, LEARNING TO ANALYZE THE UNIT'S EXTERIOR CAN PROVIDE CLUES ABOUT WHAT'S INSIDE. SOME TIPS INCLUDE:

- LOOK FOR SIGNS OF HEAVY ITEMS LIKE FURNITURE SHAPES THROUGH THE DOOR SEAMS.
- NOTE THE SIZE OF THE UNIT TO ESTIMATE VOLUME.
- CHECK IF THE UNIT LOOKS RECENTLY USED OR NEGLECTED.

ATTEND AUCTIONS IN PERSON IF POSSIBLE

WHILE ONLINE AUCTIONS ARE CONVENIENT, ATTENDING LIVE AUCTIONS CAN OFFER ADVANTAGES LIKE SEEING UNITS FIRSTHAND AND NETWORKING WITH EXPERIENCED BUYERS. BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS WITH STORAGE FACILITY STAFF MIGHT ALSO PROVIDE

INSIGHTS INTO UPCOMING AUCTIONS.

PREPARE FOR CLEANUP AND DISPOSAL

PURCHASED UNITS CAN CONTAIN JUNK OR ITEMS REQUIRING DISPOSAL. PLANNING FOR LABOR, TRANSPORTATION, AND POTENTIAL DISPOSAL FEES IS ESSENTIAL TO MANAGE COSTS AND LOGISTICS EFFECTIVELY.

RISKS AND CONSIDERATIONS WHEN BUYING ABANDON STORAGE UNITS

BUILD PARTNERSHIPS

CONSIDER PARTNERING WITH LOCAL RESELLERS, ANTIQUE SHOPS, OR ONLINE MARKETPLACES TO EXPAND YOUR SALES CHANNELS AND INCREASE PROFITS.

STAY ORGANIZED

KEEP DETAILED RECORDS OF YOUR PURCHASES, EXPENSES, AND SALES TO TRACK PROFITABILITY AND LEARN FROM PAST EXPERIENCES.
